

- Johnson Refrigeration from Chaseburg came and checked out our compressor issue and has adviced that it may cost up to \$1,000 to replace the lines and prevent any problems with refrigerant leaks. This needs to be discussed and voted on since we already had a motion passed to capture the old refrigerant, stop the leak with some chemicals, and convert our compressor to a different refrigerant.
